

## **Embossed Die Cuts | Chari Moss**


I love using die cuts on projects. You can really customize them by using different papers or embellishing them. One way to stretch your die cuts to a new level is to use them to create custom "Thicker" type embellishments which is what I did on this card by stacking multiple cuts and embossing the top layer.


## SUPPLY LIST:

Camelot Card Kit - stamps, pattern paper, cardstock, embellishments; craft die - Happy by Paper Sushi; ink-Versamark; Versafine Onyx Black; Studio Calico Color Theory Coral Bay; Studio Calico Color Theory Mint Hint; Studio Calico Color Theory Sunny Day; other silver embossing powder; heat tool; liquid glue; craft knife, acrylic blocks, post-it note tape, paper trimmer









**Step 01 :** Cut a cardstock vertically at 4.25" wide. Score at 5.5" to create a top folding vertical card base.

**Step 02 :** Cut woodgrain pattern paper to 3.75" wide x 5" high and coral star paper to 3.75" wide x 3.25" high to create the background of the card with a 1/4" border around it.

**Step 03**: Cut multiple die cuts of Happy sentiment from grey cardstock.

**Step 04:** Apply Versamark ink directly to one of the die cuts.













Step 05: Pour silver embossing powder over die cut. Use a post it note or low tack tape to hold the die cut on the back side.

**Step 06:** Using a heat tool, heat set the embossing powder. For thicker embossing apply more Versamark ink on top of first layer of melted embossing powder after it is cool and repeat the process.

**Step 07:** Use liquid glue to carefully layer together the die cuts putting the embossed die cut on the top.

Step 08: Draw a light line in pencil to see where the star paper will be, then stamp the candles so that the bottoms of them will be hidden behind the star paper panel.











**Step 09:** Assemble the pieces of the card by adhering the pattern paper to the card base then gluing the die cut embellishment to the front overlapping the two papers.

**Step 10:** Stamp the "birthday" part of the sentiment in Versafine ink.

**Step 11:** Finish by embellishing with the blue bubble embellishments from the kit. This just adds a little more shine to the project and complements the shiny silver sentiment.
